The Chairman explained that because Shropshire Council had not met their five year supply of housing sites the government's NPPF which requires all authorities to have at lease 5 years supply available at all times, means that the planning authority, when considering applications, have to ignore the Development Boundary as at the present time it does not exist.

Members of the public also expressed their concerns at the speed of traffic on Benthall Lane. Shropshire Councillor D. Turner stated that he would get the Police to investigate.
